Round 2: Rules and Guidelines

1. General Guidelines

- Each team will be assigned a specific time slot along with a meeting link. Teams must join the meeting precisely at their designated time.
 - A **non-refundable registration fee of INR 1000** is applicable, covering:
 - Registration cost for the final round (if qualified).
 - Display setup, including stalls and basic facilities & equipment, at the final venue.
 - The fee must be paid through a **Google Form**, which will be circulated to all qualified teams **individually**.
 - If a team fails to join at their allotted time, **rescheduling will not be permitted under any circumstances**.
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2. Presentation Guidelines

- Each team will have a **5-minute presentation**, followed by a **2-minute Q&A session**.
 - Exceeding the time limit will not be allowed; teams must plan their presentations accordingly.

 - Teams may customize the design freely, but all required content must be included in the designated slides.
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3. General Rules and Best Practices

- **Do not exceed the time limit**; there will be a penalty if your team takes more time than allowed. (*Technical problems or genuine reasons are exempted.*)
- The use of time is completely your choice—whether to allocate more time to demonstration and less to PPT, or any other format. **Inform the judges beforehand and proceed accordingly.**
- **Providing links as proof** that the work is yours will help the judges in the evaluation.
- **Ensure clarity in your presentation**—avoid excessive text and focus on key points to keep the judges engaged.
- **Be prepared for Q&A**—judges may ask questions related to your project, so ensure all team members are ready to respond.
- **Maintain professionalism**—speak clearly, stay confident, and respect the given time slot.
- **If using external resources or references, mention them appropriately** to avoid plagiarism concerns.

4. Evaluation and Results

- Round 2 evaluations will take place on **March 8th, 9th**.
- The results will be announced on **March 11th or 12th**.
- Teams qualifying for Round 3 will proceed to the **final round at BMSIT, Bangalore**.
